## Terrain description race areas

**Short distance:** Orienteering terrain between 700-1000 m above sea level. Mixture of coniferous and deciduous forest. Moderate to very hilly, rich in contour and rock details. Some paths and roads, and also areas of open meadows and a town area. Runnability and visibility vary from poor to good.

**Middle distance:** Orienteering terrain between 800-1100 m above sea level. Mixture of coniferous and deciduous forest. Moderate to very hilly, rich in contour and rock details. Few paths and roads, lot of undergrowth and rocky ground. Runnability and visibility vary from very poor to good.

**Long distance**: Orienteering terrain between 1600 and 2100 m above sea level. Mixture of coniferous and semi-open to open alpine pasture. Hill sides with moderate to steeper slopes. Only few paths, hardly any vegetation on the ground, rich in contour and rock details. Also areas of open meadows and a town area. Runnability and visibility mostly good, but can be reduced in semi-open areas.

A not returned rental SIAC must be replaced by DKK 500.
